Objective

The primary objective for this role is to generate and deliver geological consulting services while developing and managing customer relationships, qualifying and initiating new prospects, developing and writing proposals and responses, and acting as Principal Consultant on various assignments.

Roles and Responsibilities

- This position will be responsible for the development and delivery of professional consulting services to the exploration and mining industry to WGM's standards.
- Exemplify a high degree of personal and professional integrity.
- Manage multiple projects for established and potential clients.
- Act as Senior Geologist on technical assignments including but not limited to NI 43-101 Technical Reporting, Field Project Management, Technical Due Diligence, and Mineral Property Valuations.

Qualifications

Requirements

- Registered Professional Geoscientist in the Province of Ontario (P.Ge.)
- Minimum 10 years of industry experience in a senior role as a geologist in the exploration and/or mining industry, with 5 years of more or less continuous field experience: (1) on exploration sites or on developing mine sites; or (2) with a government funded geological survey team
- Excellent written and oral English language skills.
- Experience in three or more of the following areas: geological mapping, geochemical sampling, drill core logging, diamond drill management, exploration project management, data compilation, report (NI 43-101 or equivalent) writing.
- Minimum 5 years experience in one or more of the following commodities: precious metals, iron ore, industrial minerals, rare earths, uranium or base metals.

- Previous experience in a professional consulting role that includes sales and marketing duties and selling geological and/or mining engineering professional services by creating new business through organized prospecting and networking would be considered an asset.
- Excellent knowledge and understanding of NI 43-101 guidelines and best practices. Prior NI 43-101 authoring experience is preferred.
- Experience with small and large projects (grass roots through to feasibility), dealing with senior levels of small to major corporations.
- Build strong professional and customer relationships, and able to conduct a consultative sell by uncovering and identifying client needs.
- Ability to articulate the benefits of a portfolio of services offered by WGM with positive professional demeanour and appearance to act as a positive representative of WGM in front of clients and in the local community, as needed.
- Willingness and ability to travel abroad for short to medium term assignments (1 to 3 weeks).
- Preference to candidates with secondary language skills in Spanish, Chinese, Arabic or French.
- Detail oriented with strong organization and follow through skills, excellent written and verbal communication skills including public speaking in both one on one and formal presentation settings.
